Welcome back to Term 3.



Keeping Ourselves Safe

Over the next few weeks we will be teaching the personal safety programme **Keeping Ourselves Safe**. We teach this vital programme every two years.

Keeping Ourselves Safe has been designed to give students the skills to cope in situations involving abuse. It has three overall aims:

- to develop and strengthen children's skills to keep themselves safe with other people;
- to support and encourage abused children to get help from caring adults;
- to make teachers and parents/caregivers more aware of the need to keep children safe from abuse by adults or other children.

Keeping Ourselves Safe will be taught by your child's teacher, with support from the local Police School Community Officer as required.

Constable Rob Conder will be available to answer any questions about this programme before we start teaching it... Date to be advised.



My children are in: (tick all that apply)



How important is it to you that your child participates in a large cross country event? 101 responses


How important is it to you that your child participates in a large cross country event?

The plan...


We will be moving the Catholic Schools Cross Country to St Mary's School.

Friday the 4th of September will be the big day with Friday the 11th as a postponement date.


All Children will be training in two categories...




Does the current large cross country event have a negative effect on your child's self esteem?




Does the current large cross country event have a negative effect on your child's confidence?


If your child/ren IS NOT a competitive runner please tick which fitness training YOU would prefer.




If your child/ren IS NOT a competitive runner please tick which fitness training YOUR CHILD/REN would prefer.




If your child IS a competitive runner please tick which fitness training YOU would prefer. 46 responses




If your child IS a competitive runner please tick which fitness training THEY would prefer.


Enquiry and parent meeting will be held on Tuesday August 4, 5:30 pm in St Marys Church.
