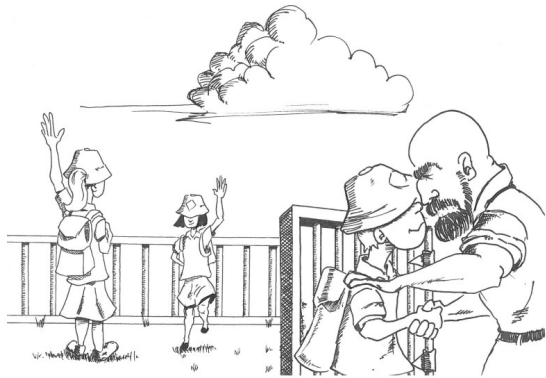

Treasure your Kaumatua / Elders



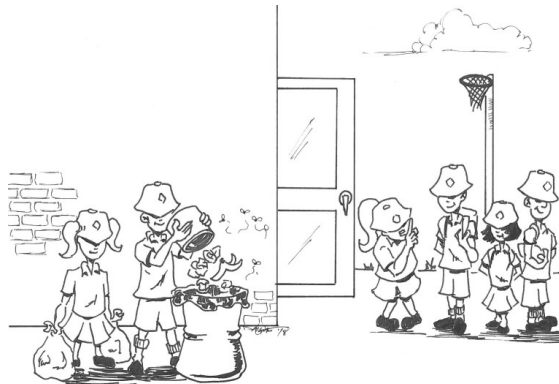

## Managing Self

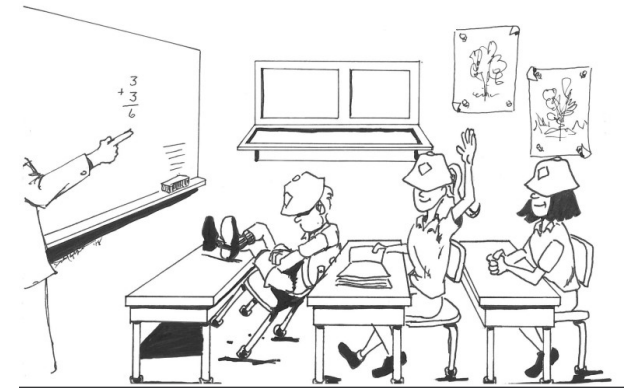
Cleaning up after myself

TEACHER AND STUDENT VOICE

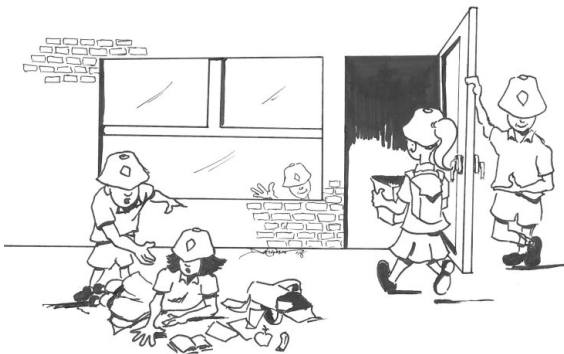
## Voice
