# Have you had a chance to look through your child's Faith Diary?

This resource is something we are trialling this year... we are pretty excited about them!

Your child should be sharing this with you each week. **Year 1 - 6 is called My Reading Record** and is a way to record weekly reading and other homework. Also you will find stories within this resource that help us to grow in God's grace. This diary will give you ideas to raise faith-filled, confident children and covers graces such as mercy, courage, obedience, joyfulness, boldness and loyalty to name a few.

## Year 7 & 8 is called My Faith Diary and focuses on several areas.

Homework first, your student is required at secondary school to keep a time management diary to keep on top of homework. It is imperative that they spend time over these two years developing good self management and sound work habits.

Student pages also provide activities essential for building knowledge and faith. Each week has links to the Reading at Mass.

Lastly it has a parent section with some important things to help you guide your child through the ever changing and challenging world we live in.

This week we look at Acceptance... there are 4 skills that we can work towards.


