Fairness

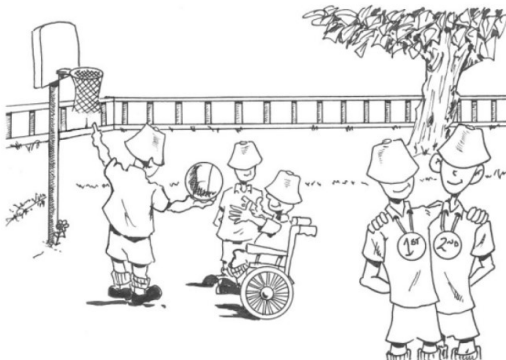
Treat others as I want to be treated.

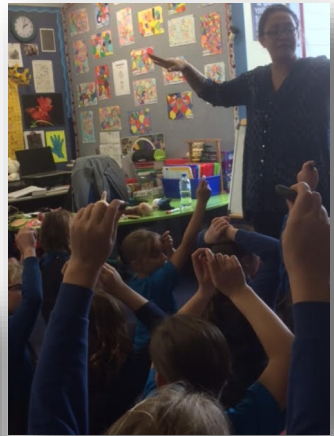

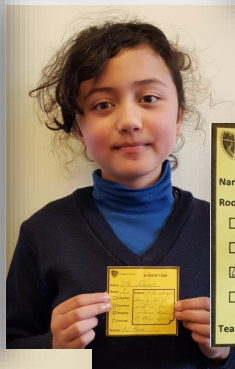
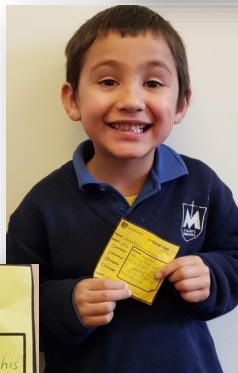
