STEM/STEAM Learning from Room 4 and Room 6


What is STEM/STEAM?

It is where we provide opportunities for students to integrate Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics to inquire, problem solve, dialogue, build relationships, build cooperative skills and use critical thinking.

Students were put in small groups of 4 to problem solve, communicate, plan, cooperate, negotiate, create... they began by hearing the story of **Cinderella** and her need for a coach to get her to the Ball.
