We began the term with our **powhiri** and I always feel such **amazing pride** for our school during this special time. We are back in **winter uniform.** We usually give a weeks grace to get items sorted. As this is a short week we ask that uniform is sorted by the end of next week. If you are unsure of what is needed please just ask.

We are very proud of our uniform and feel it plays an important role in creating a sense of unity and pride within our school community.

Uniform Reminders

We are now into the winter term.

This means new uniform and a time to polish ourselves!

Long hair - to be tied up with black or navy ties. Please keep fringes tidy and above the eyes.

**Earrings** - only plain studs or sleepers please.

Taonga and Crosses - may be worn but must be tucked in for safety reasons.

**Shoes** - Black lace up or Velcro shoes must be worn when arriving and leaving school.

We ask that shoes are plain, waterproof and black with no other colours or embellishments on them.

Please keep fancy shaved haircuts for the holiday breaks.

Term 2 heralds the beginning of those dreaded **winter illnesses.** I hoped we might have a reprieve for a few weeks but sadly that is not to be.

**Covid** is back in our midst already. Please keep your children home if they are showing any symptoms. We currently have both staff and students away with covid. Please remember there is a 7 day isolation period from the onset of symptoms.

As covid is well entrenched in our community this is now something we will learn to live with and continue life as normal. We will be using handwashing and good ventilation in classrooms as our main defence. Masks remain optional at this stage.

Please remember that students with **vomiting and diarrhoea** must stay away for **48 hours after vomiting and/or diarrhoea** has stopped. This is essential to keep bugs away from others at school.

In Special Character news there is a **children's Liturgy** which is being held at St Mary's Church on Sunday 7th May @ 9.30. This mass is completely run by our parish children and they would love you to join them and enjoy morning tea which will be served by them also.

We have had a **change of date for our whole school Mass**. Unfortunately there has been a clash with St Mary's Church. The new date has not been selected yet. We will let you know as soon as possible.

**Weekly Mass** starts this week. Every Friday morning two classrooms walk over to celebrate Mass with Cullinane College at 9.40. You are more than welcome to attend this.

**Cullinane College** have their open evening on the 2nd of May for 2024 prospective students. It starts at 5.50pm. It may seem early, however, Cullinane fills up very quickly. I encourage parents of both Year 7 and 8's to go along and have a look. This is a very important decision.

Last, but possibly the most important... I wanted to share a new **behaviour management initiative** that we have been trialling. I also want to ask for your support. We are running a Reset Room. This room is in the library and offers supervised quiet learning for students who are disrupting the learning in their classroom. The children are sent as an opportunity to reset and get their learning completed.

Parents/Caregivers will be informed by their classroom teacher if their child has been sent to the Reset Room. This is where **we need your help**. We would really appreciate you sitting down with your child to talk about respect. Respect for their teacher, respect for their fellow students and most importantly respect for their own learning. We are already seeing excellent results. We feel this is a **win win**, as not only is your child getting their learning finished, it allows the other children and teacher get on with the learning too. If you have any questions or concerns regarding this your child's teacher will be able to answer any questions.
